(d): For faster execution of these pending projects, allocation of funds have been enhanced in the past 3 budgets and regular co-ordination meetings are held with State Governments and other ministries of Government of India to expedite approvals and to remove impediments for these projects.

To expedite electrification of railway lines in the country, various steps have been taken, which inter-alia include award of turn-key contracts, cultivation of new agencies for works, better project monitoring mechanism and enhancing power of field units for award of contracts and sanction of estimates.

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
