MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a)to(d): As against a target of 91.50 MW power generation through solar power projects in the 12 Major Ports, presently 13.70 MW capacity is being generated from solar power projects functional in 8 Major Ports. The Port wise details of the solar power capacity being generated and balance to be generated is given below:-
