- (a) whether the Railways has proposed to upgrade existing unmanned level crossings to manned level crossings;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of unmanned level crossings across the country; and
- (d) the number of accidents occurred at unmanned level crossings during the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2248 BY SHRI RAMESWAR TELI TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 15.03.2017 REGARDING MANNED RAILWAY CROSSINGS

- (a) & (b): It is the endeavour of Railways to eliminate all unmanned level crossings (UMLCs) on Broad Gauge (BG) in a phased manner by either of the following:
- Closure Closing unmanned level crossings having NIL/ negligible
 Train Vehicle Unit (TVU).
- Merger Merger of unmanned level crossing gate to nearby manned/unmanned level crossing or subway/Road Under Bridge (RUB)/Road Over Bridge (ROB) by construction of diversion road.
- Provision of Subways/RUBs.
- Manning- Phased manning of unmanned level crossings, which cannot be eliminated by above means.

Ministry of Railways has announced a specific sub-mission to eliminate all unmanned level crossings on Broad Gauge by March 2020.

- (c): There are 9340 unmanned level crossings in the country as on 01.04.2016. Out of total 9340 unmanned level crossings, 6388 unmanned level crossings are on Broad Gauge (BG).
- (d): State-wise data of accidents is not maintained. However, Zone-wise number of consequential unmanned level crossing (UMLC) accidents during the last three years and the current year (upto Feb 2017) are as follows:
