The Government has set up National Clean Development Mechanism Authority (NCDMA) for evaluation and approval of Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) projects as per the guidelines and general criteria laid down in the relevant rules and modalities pertaining to CDM under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

The composition of the "National Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) Authority" is as follows:

1.	Secretary (Environment and Forests)	Chairperson
2.	Foreign Secretary or his nominee	Member
3.	Finance Secretary or his nominee	Member
4.	Secretary, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion or his nominee	Member
5.	Secretary, Ministry of New and Renewable Energy or his nominee	Member
6.	Secretary, Ministry of Power or his nominee	Member
7.	Secretary, Planning Commission or his nominee	Member
8.	Secretary, DST or his nominee	Member
9.	Joint Secretary (Climate Change), Ministry of Environment and Forests	Member
10.	Director (Climate Change), Ministry of Environment and Forests	Member- Secretary
