- (a) whether the French state-run power major EDF proposes to invest \$2 billion in renewable energy in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken effective steps to tap the huge hydropower potential and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor and the steps being taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

- (c): Small Hydro Projects (SHP) upto 25MW station capacity is classified as Renewable energy source. Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for the following activities-
- Resource Assessment, Detailed Survey & Investigation, DPR Preparation and perspective plan for States
- Capital Subsidy to State Sector Projects
- Subsidy for Private Sector Projects
- Micro Hydro & Water Mills for village electrification
- Renovation & Modernization of old SHP projects
- Research & Development and Capacity building

An aggregate capacity of 4333.85MW of SHP has been installed in the country.
