(a) whether the Government has any plan for revival of ponds in the country in view of the shortage of water;

(b) if so, the States in which ponds are being revived and water is being filled in existing ponds; and

(c) the number of ponds revived by the Government till date along with the quantum of funds spent thereon?

(a) to (c) Works related to water resources development & management are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes such as scheme for Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies etc.

To revive, restore and rehabilitate the traditional water bodies a scheme for Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies is under implementation with multiple objectives like Comprehensive improvement and restoration of water bodies thereby increasing tank storage capacity, Ground Water Recharge, Increased availability of drinking water, Improvement in agriculture/horticulture productivity etc. The scheme is now a part of Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).

Till date 12404 water bodies (1085 in pilot scheme, 10855 in XI Plan and 464 in XII Plan so far) have been revived under this scheme. The State wise details are enclosed in Annex-I. Central Assistance to the tune of Rs.4280.80 crore (Rs. 197.30 crore in pilot scheme, Rs. 3818.83 crore in XI Plan and Rs. 264.67 crore in XII Plan so far) has been released to various States under this scheme.
