2433. SHRI P.V. MIDHUN REDDY:

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Panchayats in Andhra Pradesh that have been provided with the facility of safe drinking water at public places under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP); and
- (b) the special efforts being made to achieve the target of providing safe drinking water to all by 2017?

ANSWER

(a) As reported by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh , out of 12920 GPs (48342 habitations) in the state, 7894 GPs (15305 habitations) are covered with piped water supply schemes. In the balance 5026 GPs, 17814 habitations are being covered with Piped Water Supply schemes and 15223 habitations are remaining to be provided with Piped Water Supply schemes. Public places in the GPs covered have also been provided with piped water supply.

b) As reported by State Government of Andhra Pradesh, special efforts are being made to provide safe drinking water to all habitations (Panchayats) which are not having Piped Water Supply schemes.

Project proposals are being prepared for providing safe drinking water to all habitations (i.e. not having piped water supply schemes) under Externally Aided Project (EAP) and other possible grants. It is being planned to achieve that by 2022.
