- (c) the steps taken by the Government to notify the same as NHs;
- (d) the time by which they are likely to be notified;
- (e) the total length of NHs in Gujarat, NH-wise; and
- (f) the total length of highways to be upgraded to NHs during the last three years along with expenditure thereon?

(b) to (d) Expansion of NH network is a continuous process and declaration of State roads as new NH are made from time to time depending upon requirement of connectivity, inter-se-priority and availability of funds.

The Ministry has formulated an ambitious programme inter alia to improve the road connectivity to coastal / border areas, backward areas, religious places, places of tourist interest, construction / rehabilitation / widening of major bridges and Railway Over Bridges (ROBs) / Railway Under Bridges (RUBs) on NHs and improvement of newly declared NHs, providing connectivity to District Head Quarters etc. Funding and other issues are yet to be tied up.

- (e) The total length of NHs in Gujarat, NH-wise is at Annexure-I.
- (f) The total length of highways upgraded to NHs during the last three years is at Annexure-II. Expenditure on development of NHs is incurred project-wise/scheme-wise and not NH-wise. The details of expenditure during each of the last three years is at Annexure- III.
