- (a) the details of power generating capacity in Assam by both central and State Government PSUs;
- (b) whether Assam is self-sufficient in power production, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): The power generating capacity in Assam from central and State sector is 1160 MW and 483.45 MW respectively.
- (b) & (c): The installed capacity of state sector in Assam is 483.45 MW against the peak demand of 1673 MW. The balance demand is met through the share of state in Central Sector Generating Stations. The power supply position of Assam is given at Annex.
