(a) to (c): Employment in Textiles & Apparel is mainly in the informal sector while data availability is confined to the formal sector only. As per a quick quarterly assessment on employment carried out by the Labour Bureau for the formal sector, employment generation in T&A in the last two years as may be seen from the table below:-

To enhance employment opportunities in the textile sector, Government has recently launched a special package for the apparel and made-ups sector, both of which sectors have a high employment generation potential. Additionally, the Government implements the Skill development programme which aims at enhancing the employment potential of textile workers through skilling, other infrastructure related programmes like SITP, Processing etc., capital subsidy programme like ATUFS and development programmes focusing on silk, wool, jute and Powerloom, handloom and handicraft sector with the aim of enhancing production and employment generation under textiles.
