(a) to (e): Yes Madam, Government has conducted a study on the Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks. The study has indicated that many of the textile parks have done well to ensure environment compliance and have also contributed in improving working conditions and working environment for workers. However, the parks are yet to attain their planned investment levels due to lower occupancy rates. Further, as most parks are of the size of 25 to 75 acres, the scheme has had limited impact in bringing scale to the textile industry. Government has dissemination information about the vacancy available in completed textile parks are held regional conferences with stakeholders and State Governments to review the progress of textile parks.

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
