SHIPPING SERVICES

2466. SHRI DIBYENDU ADHIKARI:

Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to conduct any survey to start shipping services between Haldia/ Shankarpur (West Bengal) and Port Blair (Andaman) to meet the demands of increased passenger transportation;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to restart shipping services on Mumbai-Goa route;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of other proposals to start new ship/cargo services amongst various ports in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING
(SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a)&(b):No, Madam. Port Blair is linked to Kolkata through passenger-cum-cargo services operated by Andaman & Nicobar Island administration. As per the information obtained from Shipping Corporation of India which manages Andaman-mainland ships on behalf of Andaman & Nicobar Administration most of the passenger ships plying on Andaman routes have fill factors of 40-50% only.
- (c)&(d):As per information furnished by Government of Goa, 'in principle' approval has been given by Maharashtra Government to start Mumbai-Goa ferry services to a shipping company.
- (e) Ships/cargo services amongst various ports of the country are planned and operated by the public/private shipping companies keeping in view the financial viability of the service. The Government provides the enabling policy and regulatory framework for operating the passenger/cargo services.
