Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Homoeopathy medical colleges functioning in the country and the number of students who are awarded degree every year, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that the students are not being enrolled this year in the temple of Hahnemann Homoeopathic Medical College located in Munger district of Bihar;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the enrolment process is likely to be restarted?

# YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a): At present there are 204 Homoeopathic Colleges functioning in the country, out of which 202 colleges are imparting Under Graduate (U.G.) education with seat intake of 14,158 and 52 colleges are imparting Post Graduate education with seat intake of 1149. (State/ UT-wise details are at **Annexure**).
- (b) to (d): Yes. Government is aware that the students were not enrolled during the Academic Year 2016-17 in the temple of Hahnemann Homoeopathic Medical College located in Munger district of Bihar. The said college was not granted permission for the Academic Year 2016-17 as it could not comply with the provisions of Homoeopathic Central Council (Minimum Standards of Requirement of Homoeopathy Colleges and attached Hospitals), Regulations, 2013. For the Academic Year 2017-18, the process of granting permission to the college has started and the enrollment process shall be completed before 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2017.
