Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from public representatives to build a Krishna Leela theme park in Mathura:
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the present status of that proposal;
- (c) whether the Government would provide financial assistance to build theme park on privately acquired land; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) & (b): Development of Tourism Infrastructure is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism has not received any proposal from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh for Central Financial Assistance for developing a Krishna Leela theme park in Mathura.
- (c) & (d): The Ministry of Tourism does not provide financial assistance for projects on privately acquired land as the same does not conform to laid down scheme guidelines.
