Will the Minister of **HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note that there is a demand to amend chapters on some historical events including the claim that the battle of Haldighati was won by Maharana Pratap and not by Akbar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the facts along with justification behind this move;
- (c) whether the Government has consulted scholars/historians from different universities in this regard;
- (d) if so, the final decision taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) the further steps taken/being taken by the Government to bring changes in history books on the basis of factual incidents?
