- (a) & (b): The signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs)/Agreements/Letter of Intent (LoI) with various countries is an ongoing process and the Ministry of Tourism has signed Agreements/MoUs in the field of tourism cooperation with Maldives, Qatar, South Africa and Kyrgyzstan in the year 2016. Details of MoUs/Agreements/Letter of Intent (LoI) signed with various countries for bilateral and multilateral cooperation in the field of Tourism may be seen at Annexure.
- (c) & (d): The main objectives of such Agreements/MoUs signed by the Ministry of Tourism include the following:
  - i) Exchange of information and data related to tourism.

- ii) Cooperation between tourism stakeholders including hotels & Tour operators.
- iii) Exchange of visits of Tour Operators/Media/Opinion Makers for promotion of two way tourism.
- iv) Exchange programmes for cooperation in Human Resource Development.
- v) Investment in the Tourism and Hospitality sector.
- vi) Exchange of experience in the areas of promotion, marketing, destination development and management.
- vii) Participation in travel fairs/exhibitions in each other's county.
