PROCUREMENT OF ELECTRONIC GADGETS

3007. SHRI P.R. SUNDARAM:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has procured adequate IT and IT enabled electronic gadgets, wireless sets, HD cameras, High end CCTV cameras, NVDs, safety and security equipments for various security organisations like CRPF, BSF, CISF, NSG and SIT;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the procurements made during the last two years, item, quantity and value-wise; and

(c) the remedial measures taken by the Government to fill up any gap in these inventories to boost the effectiveness of operations of various vital organisations like CRPF, BSF, CISF, NSG and SIT?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) have procured sufficient number of IT and IT enabled electronic gadgets and security equipment as per their operational requirement. The detail of major IT equipment procured by them during the last two years is annexed.

(c): Government has approved Modernisation Plan II (2012-17) for all CAPFs including CRPF, BSF, CISF and NSG to boost their operational effectiveness by acquiring state-of-art technology and latest equipment alongwith IT equipment. Apart from this, these CAPFs have been allocated Rs.281.95 Crores for these I.T equipments /equipment, of which Rs.240.84 Crore has been spent so far under Regular budget head.
