Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of various welfare schemes including social security schemes being run for the Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) in the country;
- (b) the estimated number of beneficiaries covered under these schemes;
- (c) the details of funds allocated and spent under these schemes during the last three years and the current year, scheme-wise and State-wise;
- (d) the mechanism in place for monitoring the implementation of the schemes run by the Government for the welfare of SCs and OBCs in the country;
- (e) whether the pace of implementation of the said schemes is very slow;
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the corrective measures taken in this regard;
- (g) whether the Government has evaluated the impact of these schemes on Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Classes and;
- (h) if so, the details and outcome thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d): The details of welfare schemes for Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) are at Annexure-I to Annexure-X. The details of mechanisms in place for monitoring the implementation of the schemes for welfare of SCs and OBCs are at Annexure-XI.

Following Schemes are being run for Scheduled Castes (SCs):

- 1. The Self Employment Scheme for the Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (SRMS):**
The Self Employment Scheme for the Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (SRMS) provides the following benefits to the identified Manual Scavengers:
 1. Onetime cash assistance of Rs.40, 000/- to identified manual scavengers.
 2. Loans for project cost up to Rs. 15.00 lacs on concessional rates of interest.
 3. Credit linked back-end capital subsidy up to Rs. 3,25,000/-.
 4. Skill Development Training up to two years with stipend of Rs.3000/- per month.

- 2. Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY):** The Centrally Sponsored Pilot Scheme 'Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana' (PMAGY) is being implemented for integrated development of 2500 Scheduled Castes (SC) majority villages having SC Population concentration > 50%. 372 villages have been declared as Adarsh Gram.

- 3. BabuJagjivan Ram Chhatrawas Yojana:** The objective of the Scheme is to provide hostel facilities to SC Boys and Girls studying in middle schools, higher secondary schools, colleges and Universities.

- 4. Pre-Matric Scholarship for SC students studying in IX and X:**
The Scheme supports parents of SC children for education of their wards studying in classes IX and X so that the incidence of drop-out, especially in the transition from the elementary to the secondary stage is minimised.

- 5. Post-Matric Scholarship for Scheduled Caste Students (PMS-SC):**
This is a centrally sponsored scheme where under 100% central assistance is released to State Governments/UTs for expenditure incurred by them under the Scheme over and above their respective committed liability.

- 6. National Fellowships for SC & OBC students for Higher Education:**
The Scheme provides financial assistance to Scheduled Caste and OBC students for pursuing research studies leading to M.Phil., Ph.D. and equivalent research degree in universities, research institutions and scientific institutions. University Grants Commission (UGC) is the nodal agency for implementing the Scheme.

- 7. National Overseas Scholarship for SCs and interest subsidy scheme for OBCs :**
National Overseas Scholarship is meant to provide assistance to selected Scheduled Caste, Denotified, Nomadic, semi-nomadic tribes, landless agricultural labourers and traditional artisan's students for pursuing higher studies of Master level courses and Ph.D programmes abroad in specified fields of study. Interest subsidy on educational loan for overseas studies for OBC students are available under the scheme.

8. Scholarship Scheme of Top Class Education for SC Students:

The objective of the Scheme is to promote qualitative education amongst SC students, by providing full financial support for pursuing studies beyond 12th class in 175 top class institutions such as IIMs, IITs, NITs (earlier known as RECs) etc.

9. Scheme for Upgradation of Merit of SC Students:

The Scheme aims to upgrade the merit of SC students studying from Class IX to Class XII, by providing them with facilities for their all-round development through education in residential schools.

The Scheme provides 100% Central assistance to the States/UTs through a package grant. Special allowances like readers allowance, transport allowance, and escorts allowance etc. is given to students with disability.

10. Pre-matric scholarship to the children of those engaged in occupations involving cleaning and prone to health hazards (earlier: Pre-matric Scholarship for Children of those engaged in Unclean Occupations):

Assistance under the Scheme consists of two components, viz

- (i) Monthly scholarship (for 10 months) Rs. 110/- per Day Scholar and Rs. 700 for Hostellers
- (ii) Annual ad-hoc Grant (to cover incidental expenses like stationery, uniform, etc.) Rs. 750/- for Day Scholars and Rs. 1000 for Hostellers.

11. Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCA to SCSP):- Under this Scheme, 100% grant is given to the States/UTs as additive to their Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP).

The following schemes are being implemented by the Government for welfare of OBCs:-

(i) Post-Matric Scholarship to the OBCs

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the OBC students studying at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education. The income ceiling of parents/guardians for eligibility is Rs.1.00 lakh per annum (including self income, if employed).

The rates under different Post-Matric Courses ranges between Rs. 750 per month and Rs. 260 per month for hostellers. For the day scholars the range is Rs. 350 to Rs. 160. Scholarship also include study tour charges @ Rs. 900 per annum (subject to actual expenditure), Thesis typing and printing charges @ Rs. 1000 (maximum), Book allowance for correspondence course @ Rs. 900 per annum and Reader charges for blind students in the range between Rs. 90 p.m. to Rs. 175 p.m.

(ii) Pre-Matric Scholarship to the OBCs

The expenditure is shared between centre and state in 50:50 ratio. The aim of this Scheme is to motivate children of OBCs studying at pre-matric stage. The income ceiling for eligibility is Rs. 44,500/- per annum.

The rates under the scheme are as follows:

Day Scholars:

Class I to V Rs. 25/- p.m.

Class VI to VIII Rs. 40/- p.m.

Class IX to X Rs. 50/- p.m.

Hostellers:

Class III to VIII Rs. 200/- p.m.

Class IX to X Rs. 250/- p.m.

In addition, Rs.500/- per student per annum to all students i.e. hostellers as well as day scholars is also given as Ad-hoc grant.

(iii) Construction of Hostels for OBC Boys and Girls

The Scheme aims at providing hostel facilities to students belonging to socially and educationally backward classes, especially from rural areas, to enable them to pursue secondary and higher education. The cost norms under the scheme are:

or as per the schedule of the rates for the concerned State Government, whichever is lower.

- d. There will also be a one-time non-recurring grant of Rs.2500/- per seat for providing furniture/equipment to the hostels constructed under the Scheme.

(iv) National Fellowship (NF) for OBC Students

The scheme aims at providing financial assistance to the OBC students in obtaining quality higher education leading to degrees such as M.Phil and Ph.D in universities, research institutions and scientific institutions.

The scheme is designed to provide a total number of 300 Junior Research Fellowships per year from the year 2014-15 onwards and 300 Senior Research Fellowships from 2016-17 to Other Backward Class (OBC) students. The UGC is the nodal agency for implementing the scheme and notifies the scheme through advertisements in the media at a suitable date. The scheme covers all universities/institutions recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC). Fellowships are awarded to research students pursuing M. Phil. and Ph.D. The rate of fellowship for JRF level is Rs. 25000 per month and for SRF level, it is Rs. 28000 per month.

(v) Assistance to Voluntary Organizations working for the Welfare of OBCs (NGO Scheme)

The purpose of this scheme is to involve the Voluntary Organization working for welfare of OBCs by providing skill up-gradation in various trades. The beneficiaries whose parents/guardians income from all sources including the income of beneficiary does not exceed Rs.1.00 lakh per annum are eligible under the Scheme. NBCFDC is also providing skill development to OBC students. The scheme has been made fully online w.e.f 2014-15.

(vi) Dr. Ambedkar Scheme of Interest Subsidy on Educational Loans for Overseas Studies for the Students belonging to the Other Backward Classes (OBCs) and Economically Backward Classes (EBCs).

The objective of the scheme is to award interest subsidy to meritorious OBC and EBC students so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education abroad and enhance their employability.

To be eligible under the scheme, a student should come under the income ceiling of Rs. 3.00 lakh per annum for OBCs and Rs. 1.00 lakh for EBCs. 50 % of the outlay every year is earmarked for Girl students.

The students should have secured admission in the approved courses at Masters, M.Phil or Ph.D levels abroad. He/She should have availed loan from a scheduled bank under the Education Loan Scheme of the Indian Banks Association (IBA) for the purpose.

Under the scheme, interest payable by the students availing the education loans of the IBA for the period of moratorium (i.e. course period, plus one year or six months after getting job, whichever is earlier) as prescribed under the Education Loan Scheme of the IBA, shall be borne by the Government of India. After the period of moratorium is over, the interest on the outstanding loan amount shall be paid by the student, in accordance with the existing Educational Loan Scheme as may be amended from time to time. The candidate will bear the Principal installments and interest beyond moratorium period.

Details of Budget Allocation and No. of Beneficiaries for Scheduled Castes (SCs):**1. The Self Employment Scheme for the Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (SRMS):**

Under the Scheme for Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers 11563 manual scavengers have been provided onetime cash assistance of Rs.40000/- each, 13390 Proposals for providing skill development training with stipend of Rs3000/- per month have been sanctioned and 1233 proposals for comprehensive rehabilitation have been sanctioned.

The mechanism adopted for monitoring the progress of implementation of the various welfare schemes for SCs and OBCs:-

- a) Review Meetings are held with State/UT officials.
- b) Performance of the schemes is monitored through annual progress reports furnished by the State Government/UT Administrations.
- c) Nodal officers have been appointed in the Ministry having State specific responsibilities for conducting parallel review/inspection/meeting with State Officials regarding implementation of the schemes, as and when required.
- d) Review Meetings are held in their respective States/UTs to take stock of progresses made by the implementing agencies and the constraints faced therein.
- e) Bi-annual Conference of State Social Welfare Ministers and the Annual Conference of State Welfare Secretaries are also organized wherein, inter alia, all the schemes of the Department of SJ&E are reviewed. In such conferences the States/UTs are also advised to strengthen their monitoring mechanism.
- f) In addition to the above, third party and scheme-specific evaluations are also taken up by the Ministry.

Impact of the Schemes of SCs and OBCs

Scheduled Castes (SC)

- i. Income generating Schemes under agriculture was highest in the State of Madhya Pradesh (100%) followed by Jharkhand (83%), Maharashtra (80%).
- ii. The Annual Husbandry Scheme was most popular in the State of West Bengal (70%) followed by Tripura (50%) and Karnataka (30%).
- iii. Schemes related to Non-Timber Forest Produce (NTFP) was most popular in Odisha (68%) followed by Chhattisgarh (12%).

Other Backward Classes (OBC)

- iv. Literacy rate among OBC has increased from 82% in 2004-05 to 90.30% in 2011-12 in the age group of 5-14 years.
- v. Literacy rate among OBC has increased from 43.1 % in 2004-05 to 64.2 % in 2011-12 in the age group of 15-19 years.
