- (a) whether the Government has prepared/proposes to formulate any action plan to provide assistance including financial, technical or otherwise to the State Governments to control industrial and environmental pollution;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of financial and technical assistance provided for this purpose during each of the last three years, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI ANIL MADHAV DAVE)

(a) to (c) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change is implementing a number of Schemes/Programmes/Projects for control and prevention of industrial and environmental pollution which include National River Conservation Programme (NRCP), National Plan for Conservation of Aquatic Eco-systems (NPCA), Assistance for Abatement of Pollution (AAP), Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs), World Bank aided Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project (CBIPMP) and Creation of Management Structure for Hazardous Substances (CMSHS) under which financial assistance is provided to the State implementing agencies. State-wise details of the funds released during the last three years under above schemes are given at Annexure I.

Financial and Technical assistance is also provided through Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) (Annexure II).

Support Extended by CPCB

- i) Support for preparing action plans for revival/ rejuvenation of polluted river stretches. CPCB has awarded work to SPCBs/PCCs for conducting comprehensive study of 29 polluted river stretches for assessment of point sources of pollution and the pollution load reaching these 29 polluted river stretches, for which an amount of RS. 145 lakhs has been released to 13 States between 2012 to 2014 (@ Rs. 5.00 Lakhs per polluted stretch).
- ii) Support National Ambient Air Quality Monitoring (NAMP) programme and National Ambient Water Quality (NWMP) Programme. Financial support provided on data purchase concept to SPCBs for last three years is given at **Appendix**.
- iii)Provided technical support to SPCBs for identification of Critically Polluted Areas in their respective states.
- iv)Capacity Building of SPCB/ PCCs officials by conducting training programmes
- v) Supported selected SPCBs for identifying contaminated sites and preparation of action plan for remediation of such sites.
- vi)Financial support provided to SPCBs for installation of Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Stations (CAAQMS). For larger states 50% installation cost is provided whereas to North Eastern states 100% financial support has been provided and in case of Union Territories 90% installation cost provided.
