Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to run Bikaner-Dadar superfast train No.12489/12490 seven days a week instead of the present twice a week in view of passenger load and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government also proposes to run Barmer-Yashwantpur AC express Train nos. 14805/14806 seven days a week instead of the present once a week; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) No, Madam.

Increase in frequency of 12489/12490 Bikaner-Dadar Express from bi-weekly to daily is not feasible at present, due to operational and resource constraints including path constraints on several sections enroute and terminal constraints at Dadar.

Increase in frequency of 14805/14806 Barmer-Yesvantpur Express from weekly to daily is not feasible at present, due to operational and resource constraints including path constraints on several sections enroute and terminal constraints at Yesvantpur.
