3279. SHRI RAMSINH RATHWA:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether revenue is collected from different private telecom operators to maintain the Universal Services Obligation Fund (USOF);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether BSNL is the main beneficiary of the fund;
- (d) if so, the total fund made available to BSNL during the last three years;
- (e) whether any private players have been able to meet the demand of providing subsidised fixed services in villages; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS & MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) & (b) The resources for meeting the Universal Service Obligation (USO) are generated through a Universal Access Levy (UAL) which is a percentage of the revenue earned by the operators under various licenses. The Universal Service Levy presently is 5% of the Adjusted Gross Revenue earned by all the operators. Revenue collected from different Private Telecom Operators to maintain the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) during last three years is enclosed as **Annexure –A.**
- (c) & (d) Telecom infrastructure development schemes are being implemented through BSNL. Funds have been provided to BSNL towards implementation of such schemes in inaccessible, rural and remote areas for fulfilling the obligation of USOF. The details of the amount disbursed to BSNL during the last three years is given below:

(e) & (f) The subsidy amounts of Rs. 0.53 crore and Rs. 2.53 crore have been disbursed from USOF to M/s TATA and M/s RIL respectively during the last three years to meet the demand of providing subsidised fixed services in villages.
