- (a) whether there is any plan to develop Udupi railway station in Karnataka and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the existing entry and exit would be widened at Udupi station and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether construction of 3rd platform has been planned ostensibly to help the student community from Manipal who use the trains running on the Konkan route; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said project is likely to be completed?**
