ANSWER

(a) The Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region along with North Eastern Council *inter alia* sponsors programmes in which artists from North Eastern States showcased the art and culture in different parts of the country. (b) In order to integrate North Eastern states with the national mainstream, the recommendations of the MP Bezbaruah Committee setup by the Ministry of Home Affairs are also being implemented. One of the key recommendations of the Committee was to educate people about North East, so as to inculcate understanding and appreciation of the culture of North East. It also talked about integration *inter alia* through cultural exchange and films. It had also talked about calendar of cultural events.

Ministry of DoNER and NEC have organised several programmes aimed at highlighting national integrity. Bharat Utsav was organised at IIC, New Delhi in December 2016 showcasing various dance forms of North East and other parts of India and the fusion of cultures in them. A North East cultural festival was also sponsored in Daulat Ram college of Delhi University. Similarly, the NEC in collaboration with International Centre, Goa sponsored North East Pavilion in Goa Arts and Literary Festival held during 08th -11th December, 2016 to showcase the talents of writers and artists from NER and help them interact with writers from other parts of India. Ministry of DoNER in collaboration with NEC has also sponsored North East troops with North East Zone Cultural Centre for holding events in the 14th Folk-Fair, 2016, National Tribal/ Folk Song & Dance Festival with the National Level Exhibition, Jagannath Dham Puri which was held from 4th to 8th June, 2016 in which the integration of all forms of tribal folk dance from across India including NER were showcased. The Ministry of Culture through its schemes namely National Cultural Exchange Programme and Octave Festival of the North East has made fruitful efforts to integrate North Eastern States with the National mainstream.

(c) All the above programmes have been very successful in emphasising the unity in diversity of Indian culture while highlighting the beauty and cultural richness of NER. The Ministry of Culture through North East Zonal Culture Centre has provided a common platform to the artists from the North Eastern States and from other zones for a meaningful interaction. Such close interaction is the success to integrate North Eastern States with the National mainstream.
