PROCESSING E-WASTE

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether inhalation or exposure to acids being used to separate the metals in the electronic products, cause serious health problems while processing e-waste; and
- (b) if so, the protective measures the Government has taken/proposed to be taken while dealing with e-waste?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): Yes.
- (b): The e-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide GSR 338 (E) dated 23.03.2016 envisage health protective measures in processing of e-waste. The said Rules are supported by the Implementation Guidelines issued by the Central Pollution Control Board.
