- (b) whether investment and private participation in the mining sector are likely to increase as a result of the same and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The National Mineral Exploration Policy (NMEP) has been notified by the Central Government in July, 2016. The policy has number of features aimed at accelerating mineral exploration in the country. It is available on the website of Ministry of Mines (<http://mines.nic.in/writereaddata/Content/NMEP.pdf>).

The NMEP facilitates greater role of private sector in mineral exploration, It proposes, inter -alia, to attract private exploration agencies through revenue sharing mechanism, carry out aerogeophysical mapping of the country, make available baseline data free of cost as public good, collate and share data of various exploration agencies, and provide a structured framework for targeting deep-seated and concealed mineral deposits.
