(d) Government is regularly monitoring the traffic and trade at Major Ports. To reduce the gap between the traffic and capacity, interactive meetings with user Ministries and Departments like Fertilizers, Petroleum, Coal, Power, Food and Civil Supplies are held from time to time for assignment of their cargo to Major Ports. Major Ports also organise trade meets to attract traffic and new cargo from their hinterland.
