(a) whether the Government has inaugurated the first integrated Heliport in Delhi:

(b) if so, the details thereof including facilities provided therein and the number of helicopter arrivals and departures to be handled by this heliport on daily basis;

(c) the employment to be generated from the said heliport and the steps taken/being taken by the Government to set up more Heliports/Helipads in various parts of the country;

(d) whether the Government has decided to set up three other Heliports besides one already established in Delhi and if so, the details thereof; (e) the total number of helipads in various parts of the country, State/UTwise

(e) the total number of nelipads in various parts of the country, state of wise and the places which are to be connected by heliport services in the country; and

(f) whether the Government proposes to construct more helipads in the country and if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam. Rohini Heliport has been inaugurated on 28 February, 2017. The heliport has provisions for operational facilities and Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul (MRO) and the following facilities:

(i) Centrally air-conditioned Passenger terminal building having the capacity

to handle 150 passengers

(ii) Four hangers of 3600 sqm area (each hanger with 900 sqm)

(iii) Parking capacity for 12 helicopters

(iv) Fire services.

The heliport is designed to handle approximate 140 helicopter operations per

day.

(c): As per ICAO study - "Economic benefits of civil aviation: ripples of prosperity", the output and employment multipliers of aviation are 3.25 and

6.10 respectively.

(d) to (f): Ministry of Civil Aviation has issued the National Civil Aviation Policy (NCAP-2016). NCAP has the provision of development of four regional helihubs in the Country, namely Northern, Western, Eastern and Southern Region. A Heliport has already been developed at Rohini, New Delhi. List of total number of helipads is attached as Annexure 'A'. In compliance with the NCAP-2016, Ministry of Civil Aviation has launched Regional Connectivity Scheme, which inter-alia permits helicopter operation among the States of J&K, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, North Eastern Region of India, A&N Islands and Lakshadweep Islands. However, development of regional air connectivity routes is demand driven and left to market forces, such that airline operators undertake assessment of demand of supply required on a particular route. Helipads in States/Union Territories are generally constructed and maintained by State Government on requirement basis.
