(a) & (b) Central Ground Water Board monitors the ground water level of the Country at periodical intervals in the month of January, April / May, August and November. The postmonsoon (November) ground water level in general represents the gain in ground water resource after rainfall and is reflected in ground water level. State/ UT-wise rise in water level in November 2016 in comparision with mean November (2013 to 2015) water levels is given at **Annexure**.
