UG AND PG SEATS

3722. SHRI M.B. RAJESH:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to increase the admission capacity of UG (BAMS) and PG seats in various streams of AYUSH colleges; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise and stream-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA,

YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a): Yes. There are provisions to increase the admission capacity of Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate seats in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy colleges, which are prescribed in the following regulations:
- i. The Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 (for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani).
- ii. The Establishment of New Medical College (Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College) Regulations, 2011 (for Homoeopathy).
- (b): During the year 2016, the Central Government has received 38 applications to increase the admission capacity of Under-graduate course of Ayurveda, Unani and Homoeopathy and 05 applications to increase the admission capacity of Post-graduate course of Ayurveda. The State/UT-wise and stream-wise details are given at **Annexure.**
