Effects of Demonetisation on Micro Finance Industry

QUESTION

3740. Shri Chandra Prakash Joshi:

Will the Minister of **FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether according to the report by Microfinance Institutions Network (MFIN), demonetization took a heavy toll on cash driven micro finance industry as both the number of loans given and amount disbursed fell significantly in the December quarter;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and loans provided to micro-finance industry during the last six months, State/UT- wise; and
- (c) the corrective steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): As per MFIN, Micro Finance Institutions (MFIs) disbursed 59.22 lakh loans worth Rs.12,424 crores during Oct-Dec Financial Year (FY) 2016-17 as compared to 79.82 lakh loans worth Rs.14,707 crores during Oct-Dec FY 2015-16. As per information furnished by Reserve Bank of India (RBI), region wise details of total borrowings of NBFC-MFIs with asset size more than Rs.500 crores as at end of September 2016 and December 2016 are furnished as per Annex.

(c): RBI has removed all restrictions on cash withdrawal from Current as well as Saving account with effect from January 30, 2017 & March 13, 2017 respectively. Further RBI vide circular dated November 21, 2016 and December 28, 2016 has advised all entities regulated by them to provide an additional 90 days beyond what is applicable for the concerned regulated entity (RE) for recognition of a loan account as substandard, in specified cases.
