(a) & (b): Yes, the Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) for the year 2016-17 under National Health Mission (NHM) was received from the State Government of Karnataka. The details are available at URL <http://nhm.gov.in/nrhm-in-state/state-program-implementation-plans-pips.html>.

(c) & (d): Public health & hospitals is a State subject. As per information received from the State Government of Karnataka, there is no shortfall of Primary Health Centres (PHCs). As per Rural Health Statistics (RHS) 2015-2016, there are 2353 Primary Health Centres functioning in the State of Karnataka against the required number of 1306 as per the national population norms for setting up a PHC.
