ANSWER

(SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- Yes Madam. Stalled highway projects are in different stages of restructuring and (a) and (b) rebidding. After the rebid, the Concessionaire(s)/Contractor(s) successful in the bid can apply for loan to the bank(s), which would be provided by the bank(s) the to Concessionaire(s)/Contractor(s) as per their request, requirement and eligibility, and in conformity with the bank(s) guidelines.
- (c) No such instance has come to the notice of the Government so far.
- (d) Does not arise.
