(a): The State of Maharashtra has submitted proposal for 4142 Additional Classrooms (ACR) and 2285 classrooms against dilapidated buildings for reconstruction and 92 school buildings for building less primary schools in Annual Work Plan & Budget (2017-18) Proposal.

(b): In the beginning of every financial year, States and Union Territories submit their respective proposals for the ensuing financial year based on gaps as per Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE) data and State Schedule of Rates for consideration and approval of Project Approval Board (PAB) in Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD). These proposals are considered by the PAB based on admissibility and justification.

The proposal for 2017-18 is under examination of the Ministry as per the existing norms of the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA); which is a continuous process.
