The 18th Round of India – Canada negotiations on Foreign Investment Promotion and Protection Agreement (FIPA) / Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) was held during Feb 6-8, 2017 in New Delhi. India – Canada bilateral meeting was held on 03.03.2017 between Hon'ble Commerce and Industry Minister and Minister of International Trade, Canada to discuss areas for furthering bilateral trade including discussions on expediting CEPA.
