### **Bank Accounts for Unorganised Sector**

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the banks have launched a massive drive to open banks accounts of labourers and unorganised workers in villages and unbanked areas after the demonetization;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of camps organised by public sector banks till date after the demonetization, bank-wise;
- (c) the number of new bank accounts opened and the number of cards issued during the said period, bank-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has taken/proposes to take any steps for disbursement of wages/salary to labourers in unorganized sector digitally in the country and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to open banks in unbanked areas in the country?

# Answer

## The Minister of State in the Ministry of Finance

#### (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a) to (c) The government advised Public Sector Banks (PSB) to organise special camps to open accounts of the workers in unorganised sector and during 23.11.2016 to 27.01.2017, 5.3 lakh camps have been organized, 91.66 lakh accounts have been opened in these camps across the country. Bank-wise number of camps organized and accounts opened is Annexed. The total number of RuPay cards issued by PSBs till 18.01.2017 is 17.06 crore. Bank wise details are contained in the Annexure.
- (d) and (e) The government has advised banks to make special arrangements to facilitate payment of wages/salaries of workers such as providing mobile ATMs in industrial clusters. Banks have also been advised to deploy bank mitr in the tea gardens for opening of bank accounts and to carryout transactions. Banks have deployed 1.26 lakh bank mitr in sub-service areas to provide banking services in rural areas.
