Madrasa Buildings

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the grant for construction of Madrasa buildings under Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutes (IDMI) Scheme provided by the Government and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the allocation under the said scheme during the current financial year; and
- (c) whether the Government schemes likely to continue to upgrade the infrastructure of Madrasas to facilitate quality improvement in education and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): No Madam. The Scheme of Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutes (IDMI) does not provide funds for construction of building of Madrasa. It facilitates education of minorities by strengthening school infrastructure in Minority Institutions (private aided/unaided elementary/ secondary/ senior secondary schools). It funds to the extent of 75% subject to a maximum of Rs. 50 lakhs per school. The Scheme encourages education of girls, children with special needs and children from the more educationally backward minorities in the State. A total Budget of Rs.26.50 Crore has been allocated for IDMI under the Scheme for Providing Education to Madrasas/ Minorities(SPEMM) during the current financial year. At present, there is no proposal to discontinue IDMI Scheme.

Ministry of Minority Affairs implements the Scheme of Multi-Sectoral Development Programme for Minorities, under which the infrastructure like construction of buildings, hostels etc. are approved for Madrasas which fulfill the condition that the ownership of the assets credited thereof would have to be with the State Government/ Government Body.
