- (b) the aims and objectives of the said Institutes and the extent to which these institutes have been able to meet them;
- (c) the funds allocated/sanctioned by the Government and the utilization reported therefrom during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to open more such Institutes in the country and has received proposals from various States in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken/being taken by the Government on such proposals so far, State/UT-wise;

(a) & (b) Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs) have been set up in various State Governments with the aims and objectives of providing planning inputs, conducting research and evaluation studies, collection of data, identify challenges in the field of socio-economic development, promotion & preservation of culture, training and capacity building of stakeholders, and knowledge advocacy that would help formulate evidence based policy and planning for tribals.

Under Central Sector Scheme 'Support to TRIs', Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been extending financial support to TRIs set up by States for identified activities such as research & evaluation studies, documentation & preservation, organising workshops / seminars / trainings, purchase of books for library, purchase, maintenance and preservation of artifacts for existing museum, organising exchange visit of tribals to other States etc. List of such TRIs is at Annexure I. These TRIs have been able to meet the aims and objectives to full extent.

(c) Funds allocated / sanctioned by the Government under above Scheme and utilization reported by TRIs during the last three years and the current year, State / UT-wise is at Annexure II.

(d)&(e) TRIs are set up by State Governments.
