(a), Yes, Sir. A monitoring committee for overseeing outbreak of H5 avian influenza in the(b) & (c) country has been constituted.

The composition of the said committee is as follows:

- 1. Member Secretary, Central Zoo Authority Chairman
- 2. Director, National Zoological Park- Member Convenor
- 3. Deputy Inspector General of Forest(WL)- Member

The Committee's mandate falls on the monitoring of the daily incidences of H5 Avian Influenza in National Zoological Park and other Zoos of the country.
