(a) whether the Government proposes to bring out a bill titled "the Allied and Healthcare Professionals' Central Council Bill"; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and the objects and reasons therefor and the present status of the bill?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

(a): Yes. A Bill to form council for unregulated Allied Health Professionals is under discussion.

(b): The proposed bill is to establish a Central Healthcare Council to standardize and regulate allied healthcare profession education. It is under discussion in the Ministry.
