- (a) the details of the assistance, financial or technical provided by the Government for conservation and development of National Parks and Wildlife sanctuaries in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (b) the plan and non-plan expenditure of the Government on conservation of Wildlife in Uttar Pradesh during each of the last three years, scheme-wise?

(a)&(b) Financial assistance and technical assistance in the form of Management Effectiveness Evaluation (MEE) of Protected Areas by the experts, advisories on management of Human-wildlife conflicts etc. have been provided for conservation and development of National Parks and Wildlife sanctuaries in Uttar Pradesh under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes of 'Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats' and 'Project Tiger'.

Details of funds released to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh under these Centrally sponsored Schemes (Plan schemes) for conservation and development of National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries during the last three years are as below:
