- (b) if so, the details thereof and the funds allocated for this purpose?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam, this Ministry has received a proposal from the Government of Andhra Pradesh worth Rs. 858.37 crore for replication of the State of Art Greyhounds Training Centre near Amaravathi in Andhra Pradesh. The proposal consists of setting up of State-of-the-Art Training Centre and Tactical Headquarters for Greyhounds near Amaravathi, and an Operational Hub at Kurnool. No funds have been allocated so far, for this purpose.
