- (a) the details of revenue received from Indirect Taxes other than Customs Duty during the last three years and current year;
- (b) whether a large part of the currency issued in the form of Rs. 1000 and 500 notes prior to demonetisation has been deposited and has come into the system;
- (c) if so, the amount deposited so far;
- (d) the extent to which the said deposit has boosted the Direct and Indirect Taxes; and
- (e) whether the increase in the taxes is likely to decrease the fiscal deficit, if so, the details thereof?
