Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways are planning to introduce a new train in Karnataka linking Mangalore-New Delhi via Madgaon-Kota, Subrahmanya Road-Dadar via Madgaon and Mangalore-Hubli via Madgaon in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Railways are also planning to introduce a new train in Karnataka linking Mysore-Chandigarh via Hubli-Madgaon-Kota and Mysore-Mata Vaishnodevi Katra Station via Madgaon-Vadodara-Delhi; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) and (b): At present, there is no proposal to introduce a new train linking Mangalore-New Delhi via Madgaon-Kota, Subrahmanya Road-Dadar via Madgaon and Mangalore-Hubli via Madgaon.
- (c) and (d): At present there is no proposal to introduce a new train linking Mysore-Chandigarh via Hubli-Madgaon-Kota and Mysore-Mata Vaishnodevi Katra station via Madgaon-Vadodara-Delhi.
