- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from various State Governments for Mono Rail Projects;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether all the said projects have been approved by the Government;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the present status of these projects?

- (a) & (b): Government of India has received the following Mono Rail projects proposals:

(c)to (e): Government of India, vide letter dated 11.11.2014 has accorded 'in principle' approval to Phase-I without any financial liability. For Phase-II, Government of Tamil Nadu (GoTN) was requested to submit comprehensive Detailed Project Report (DPR) along with other relevant documents. GoTN has informed that for Phase-I, fresh tender process is to be initiated by them. For Phase-II, GoTN has not sent the comprehensive DPR.
