**CSC TO IMPART SKILL TRAINING**

Will the Minister of Electronics and Information Technology be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Ministry has signed an agreement with cab service company Uber to use Common Services Centres (CSCs) to impart skills training to drivers and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the aims and objectives of the aforementioned agreement and whether this partnership could provide people at the grassroots level the opportunity to become successful micro-entrepreneurs and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the other initiatives undertaken by the Government to promote access to skill development and micro-entrepreneurship opportunities?

(c): CSC SPV has collaborated with Larsen & Toubro, Hero Motocorp, Society for Clean and Healthy Environment (SoCHE), Knowledge Podium and Siemens for skill enhancement and better opportunities towards micro-entrepreneurship.
