**(a) & (b) : There is no plan to start another e-ticketing website. The e-ticketing website [www.irctc.co.in](http://www.irctc.co.in) is managed by organisations owned by Indian Railways viz., Centre for Railway Information Systems (CRIS) and Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation Limited (IRCTC).**

**The e-ticketing website has been upgraded and about 15000 tickets per minute can be booked on this website which is sufficient to cater to the present requirement.**
