STOPPAGE OF POOJA EXPRESS

†4542. SHRI RAMESH BIDHURI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received representations regarding stoppage of Pooja Express (Train No.12413) and Mandore express (Train No.12461) at Bijwasan Railway Station and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the said stoppage will prove to be beneficial for the Railways in view of the large number of employees working in Government institutions adjoining Delhi-Haryana border area and Bijwasan; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Railways in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c) Requests/representations for stoppage of trains are received at various levels of Railways administration viz. Stations, Divisional level, Zonal level and Railway Board's level and action as found feasible and justified is taken from time to time.

At present, 13 pairs of train services (05 pairs in morning and 04 pairs in the evening) are plying between Bijwasan and Delhi which are considered adequate for the present level of traffic. 12461 Delhi-Jodhpur Mandore Express presently stops at Bijwasan station for the use to daily commuters. Stoppage of 12413/12414 Ajmer-Jammu Tawi Express and 12462 Jodhpur-Delhi Mandore Express at Bijwasan is not feasible, at present.
