(a) whether India and Portugal have signed Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) for cooperation in defence sector to boost joint production and development of weapons systems and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether under the aforesaid agreements joint ventures and commercial partnership will be set up under Make in India programme and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether joint ventures and commercial partnership will be based on the joint production and technology transfer and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the extent to which India is likely to be benefitted from the aforesaid agreements?
