- (a) the number of the Railway crossings constructed on the National Highways across the country including Maharashtra, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has prepared any proposal for constructing the overbridge and underpasses on these railway crossings;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of surveys conducted in this regard during the last three years?

- (a) to (d) Yes Madam. About 1831 railway level crossing have been identified on National Highways in the country. Out of which, 1137 Railway Over Bridge (ROBs)/ Railway Under Bridge including 104 in Maharashtra have already been constructed. Out of the remaining 694 ROB/RUBs including 25 in Maharashtra, 208 are under Setu Bharatam project and 486 under corridor development.
