RING ROAD IN RANCHI

4648. SHRI RAM TAHAL CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Jharkhand for the completion of the construction work of Ring Road in Ranchi lying pending for the last several years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the date of receiving of such proposals; and
- (c) the action taken thereon so far by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (c) The Ministry has not received any proposal from the Government of Jharkhand for the completion of Ring Road in Ranchi. However, the Ring Road of Ranchi is constructed in seven segments. Two segments covering a length of 25.32 km are being constructed by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) as a part of four laning of Ranchi - Rargaon - Mahulia section of NH-33 and remaining five segments covering a length of 59.68 km by State Government of Jharkhand.
